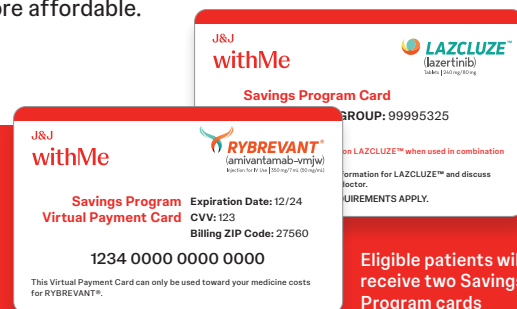


Commercial or private insurance? (Insurance issued by an employer)

Eligible patients pay \$0 for each RYBREVANT® infusion and LAZCLUZE™ prescription fill when RYBREVANT® is used in combination with LAZCLUZE™
